Homework - Boat Safety Items

Before you launch the boat you should always carry out a basic safety check on the following:

What do we ch	eck? How and why do we check it?
1 The hull	No holes that would let in water - that might cause the boat to sink
2 Bow ball	In place and secure, covering the hard plastic point of bow - reduces risk of injury or damage to other crew or boat in a collision
3 Rudder and (not all boats these, thoug	and so avoid collision with other boats or
4 Riggers, pir swivels and	
5 Heel restrai	In place and of correct length - so that shoes come up no higher than level - this means that if boat capsizes, rower can pull foot out
6 Seat and sli	Seat in place and running smoothly - to avoid a sudden stop and thus injury
7 Hatch cover	In place and fitted tightly and correctly – so that water does not get into the buoyancy tanks, which could make the boat sink
