### 'CHAMPION OF THE TYNE'

Divisions 1 & 2 are to be rowed upstream and Division 3 downstream, all over 500m approx, with finish in all cases at or about Tyne ARC steps. The courses will not be buoyed and there will be a free start in all races. Masters handicaps to be applied at the finish.

Minimum of 3 entries per event to run. We will get in touch after close of entries to try and ensure you get a race if there are not 3 crews in your category. Please say if you are not willing to 'race up' on entry. No doubling up within divisions unless agreed.

Entry fees £8 senior, £6 junior per seat, coxes free. Entries on BROE only; payment to be made once entry accepted formally. Entries will close at 8.00pm on Thursday 9th June 2016.

## **Terms and Conditions**

1. Entries will be by BROE only and will close at 8.00pm on Thursday 9th June 2016. The draw will be made at 8.00pm on Monday 13th June 2016 at Tyne ARC and will be made available at [www.tynerowingclub.org](http://www.tynerowingclub.org) as soon as possible thereafter.
2. Crews who change status on Saturday 11th or Sunday 12th June at Nat Masters or Durham Regatta or otherwise (well done!) should inform the Regatta Secretary as below by 8.00pm of the same day. They shall be transferred to the next highest status event being run.
3. Event fees are not refundable once the draw is published except that in the event of the regatta being cancelled, either in part or in whole, the Organising Committee will refund all entry fees subject to unavoidable expenses.
4. The Organising Committee reserves the right to withdraw any event with fewer than 3 entries. Entrants should indicate if they are not willing to be moved up in status or into another age category (with handicaps applied) in the event of insufficient entries in their preferred event. Junior A and B status may be combined if insufficient entries are received in either.
5. Boating will take place from Tyne ARC and possibly Tyne United RC and Newcastle University BC. Clubs will be advised of their boating location when the draw is published. **Please note trailers for clubs boating at Tyne ARC and racing in Division 1 will have to arrive by 10.00am due to the clubhouse opening ceremony taking place 11.00 onwards. All welcome to opening ceremony (and procession of boats)!**
6. Race Control will be located at Tyne ARC and numbers will be available there.
7. All crews must compete as per their entry on BROE. However, subject to being allowable under the Rules of Racing, substitutes can be notified to Race Control, but this must be done *before* the crew goes afloat. Those notifying changes should provide the registered club, name, date of birth and racing licence number for new crew members.
6. Coxes requiring dead weight must bring their own, clearly identifiable, weights. All boats must be fitted with plastic slots for bow numbers. Boats may be inspected to ensure compliance with safety standards set out in the Rules of Racing and may be turned back from the boating steps if not compliant.
7. Competitors should boat with their opposition if at all possible, but in any case should be in the start marshalling area 10 minutes before the time of their race. The Starter will start all races without reference to absentees.
8. Masters Handicaps will be applied at the finish in accordance with the guidance in the British Rowing Almanack.
