Car parking advice for Ponteland Junior Head 2019

Parking at clubs

Trailers and towing vehicles can park at their host clubs, as per the final start order when issued at Tyne ARC or Tyne United ARC. There is no parking for competitors except for club mini-buses at these host clubs.

Competitor parking

Competitors are advised to park in the public car park at the Country Park (west) end of Grange Road on the north (Newburn) side of the river (top left in map overleaf), and walk back along the riverside to the clubs - it's not far!

There will also be limited space at Newcastle University Boat Club just south and east of Newburn Bridge - first come, first served.

Where not to park!

Please **do NOT** park on **Water Row (the narrow road down to Tyne ARC)** or on **Grange Road** outside the terraced housing or on **Station Road** down to the lights from the main road or on the **immediate bridge approaches** either side of the river. **Or on the grass verges anywhere!**

Please note that at previous events the police have issued fines for parking in dangerous locations or where it might restrict access for emergency services. See map overleaf with no-go areas marked in red and car parking in blue.
